### Biographical Note

Ida Diller Record (1886-1975?) was a Millikin student who graduated in 1907. She married a Millikin alumnus, Charles Record. She was active in the Chi Sigma Phi sorority, German Club, Glee Club, Y.M.C.A., and was the Literary Editor of the *Millidek*. Her senior thesis was titled *The Economic Place of Woman*. The 1907 *Millidek* states next to her picture, “‘Idear’ is very solemn and sober and always has lots to do. She is one of our best girls save for one grandmotherly characteristic; she worries for the lack of worries when she has none.”

### Scope and Content Note

This collection contains Commencement and Baccalaureate programs from 1904-1907, various programs from plays, student recitals, fraternity banquets, Orlandian Society and the Junior-Senior banquet from 1906. There are also many different types of photographs, including: miscellaneous personal, early photos of campus buildings, bookstore (?), Albert Taylor Hall, 1904 JMU football team and other athletic photos, social event photographs, photos of classmates (possibly Decatur High School), candid photos of students. Invitations to events, JMU “Yells” pamphlet, Chi Sigma Phi (social sorority) paraphernalia, and various newspaper articles of particular interest are also included. Along with the Sears Collection, this collection provides good insight into life at James Millikin University during its infancy.
