Dr. Robert E. Shimp was named provost and vice president for academic affairs of Millikin University in 1988. He was named acting president due to the unexpected leave of absence and death of Millikin's tenth president, Dr. John R. Miltner, in September, 1992. Though many faculty lobbied for the naming of Shimp as official president, Dr. Shimp accepted a position as ninth president of McMurry University in Abilene, Texas. Before his time at Millikin, Shimp was academic dean at Kentucky Wesleyan College. Preceding his time as an academic dean, Shimp was a history faculty member of Ohio Wesleyan University for sixteen years. He earned his bachelor's degree from Thiel College in Pennsylvania, and his master's and doctorate from Ohio State University.

This small collection of administrative papers features assorted memoranda, cabinet meeting minutes, interdepartmental communications, and annual fund reports.
